

## Survey of High School Students Regarding their Parents' Most Important Hopes & Values

(Original Survey by Harvard Professor Richard Weissbourd, as reported in his book, *The Parents We Mean To Be*)

**Instructions to Students:** Place the numbers 1 – 5 in the blank in front of the following five possible hopes and values your parents convey to you, with the number 1 in the blank in front of the statement you believe your parents have as the *most important* value/outcome for you; the number 2 in the blank in front of the statement you believe your parents have as *the next most important* value/outcome for you, etc. to 5, which is the statement you believe your parents have as the *least most important* value/outcome for you. The survey is anonymous, so only the collective results will be analyzed and shared.
